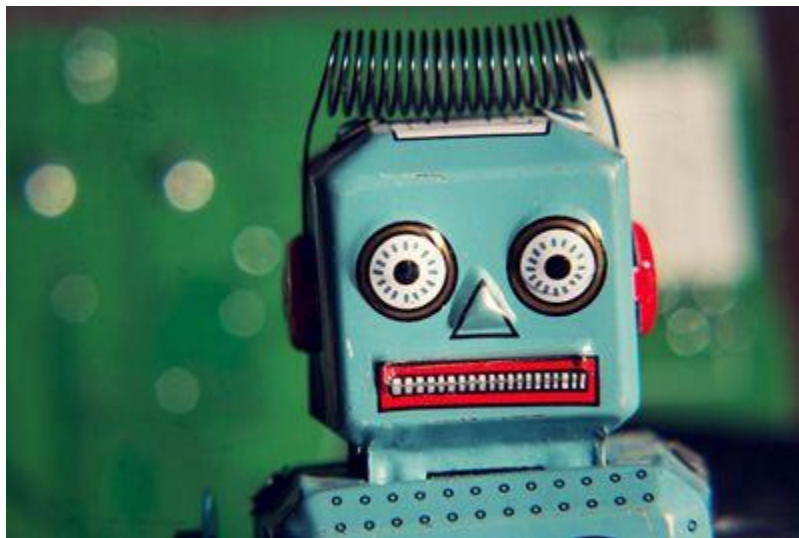
TP Transcription & University of Salford Awarded £290k for Research Project

Researchers discovered that over 1% of Whisper AI generated audio transcriptions contained completely fictional phrases and sentences which did not match in any way the spoken word on the audio file.
